Student 'Start-up' Competition

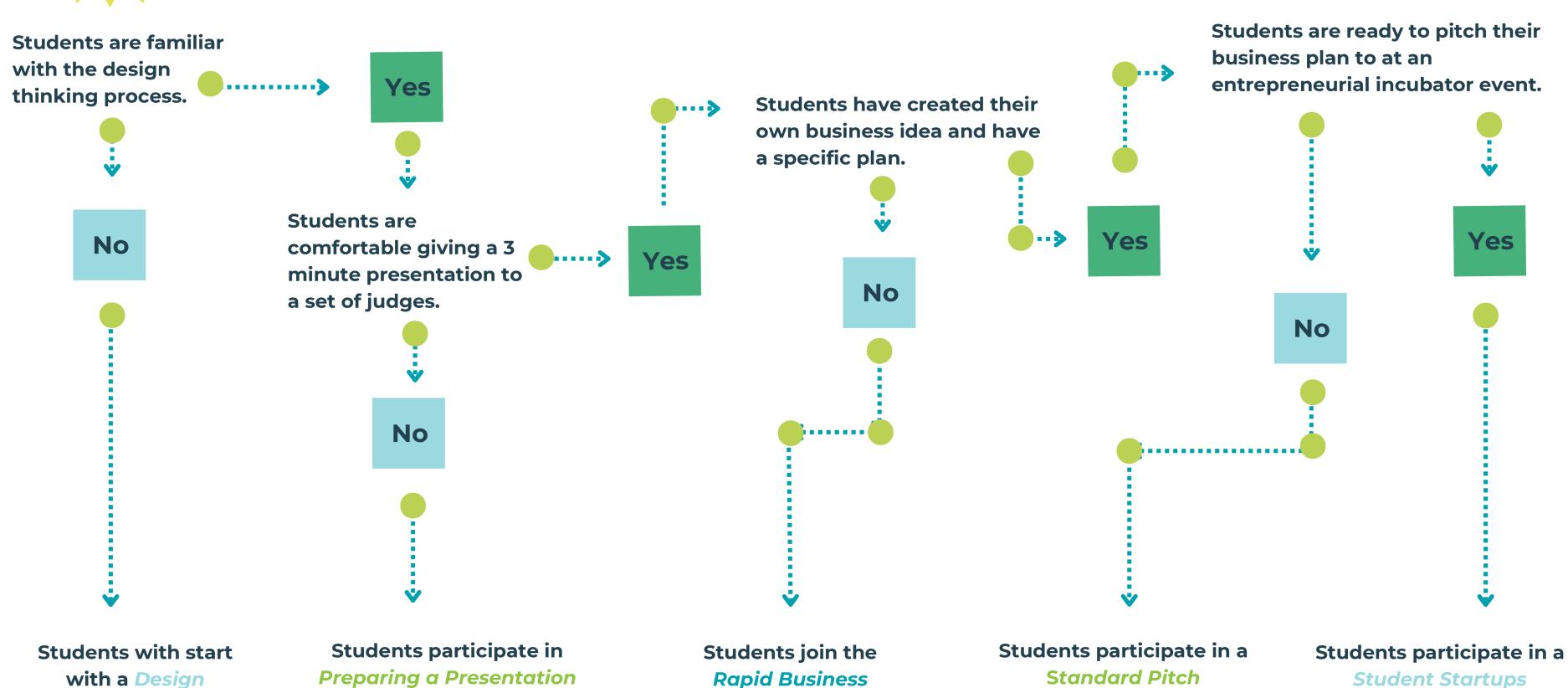
