On , our class will visit <i>JA BizTown</i> , a unique experiential learning program operated by Junior Achievement of Greater Kansas City. This on-site visit is the culminating activity of the curriculum that focuses on community and economy, work readiness, financial literacy, and business management.	
During their time at <i>JA BizTown</i> , students will take on the role of citizens and employees in one of 20 different businesses. They will experience economics in action—producing or selling products, earning paychecks, working as part of a business team, repaying business loans, shopping, and managing a personal bank account.	
To ensure a successful visit to JA BizTown, we need 25 to 30 adult volunteers to accompany us and help facilitate the simulation activities. Volunteers will play an essential role in guiding students as they operate their assigned businesses and manage the responsibilities of citizenship in JA BizTown.	
All volunteers are required to attend a 45-minute training session on the morning of the visit. This training will cover the on-site schedule, procedures, and your role as a volunteer. Volunteers must arrive at JA BizTown one hour before the students and therefore are unable to ride the bus with their student to the facility.
